Free Agent Youth Soccer Program Information

******Be sure to check schedules often at soccermac.com******

Frequently asked questions:

What is a free agent? Free agents are individual players that we place on teams.

What does the U stand for? The U stands for “under”. U6 kids that are 6 as of August 1st, U8 kids that are 8 as of August 1st etc..

What is the MAC Soccer Maintenance fee used for? This fee will be used to help maintain the indoor fields, make purchases, repairs and support administrative costs.

How do I register my child? Fill out the MAC Soccer Maintenance/Wavier along with a registration form. There is a registration fee for each session, and the MSM fee is due every August 1st. Registration forms are available on line or at the MAC (FIT front desk). You can mail or bring in your forms.

Can we request to be with a friend? We will try to put your player with another player if requested, however we make no guarantee.

When do we play games? Youth free agents practice one evening a week and play a game on Saturday or Sunday. Your practice day should remain the same but the game day and times will vary.

How do I know what team my child has been placed on? Sometimes we don't know until very close to the start of a session exactly which kids will play on which teams. We will post the roster at soccermac.com as soon as possible, or you can call or e-mail us to check.

Why would I be asked to change my requested time or day? We can not always predict the number of players we will have for each session. We will add or delete practice times based on the number of teams we have for each session and we may need to ask some players to switch days in order to keep a good ratio of players per team.

What should my child wear and bring? Shorts, t-shirts (MAC issued game shirt) and athletic shoes. Soccer shoes with plastic cleats can also be worn but are not required. We strongly recommend shin guards and always bring a water bottle.

How do I know when games are scheduled? Check the soccermac.com web site often. Each team will be named and a roster for each team will be posted on line as soon as possible. However, the roster can change with the number of players we have.

What if we can't make a practice or game? Please let your coach know or you can send us a quick e-mail.

Why are there times when we have a different coach? All our MAC coaches are qualified to coach these teams. If a coach has a scheduling conflict, we don't reschedule all the kids, we have one of our other coaches help out.

Do I have to participate in fund raising or pay a “buy out” fee? No, you do not have any fund raising responsibilities when you play as a free agent at the MAC.
